The Curricular Area: Technology - Digital technology

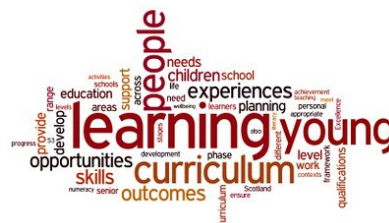
Why? Digital technology enhances and supports a child's learning across the curriculum, as well as being crucial life skill for the 21st century.

What? Digital technologies are electronic resources that make, store or process data.



How? Resources used are ipads, laptops, desktop computers, smart boards, digital cameras, easi-speaks and programmable toys.

Jargon Explained . . .



Easi-speak – a hand held microphone that children can use to record and playback their own voice

Smart board – an interactive whiteboard which displays the desktop image from a laptop, computer or ipad. The whiteboard accepts touch input from a finger, pen or other solid object.

Programmable toys – a device that can move forwards/backwards/right and left that children have to program to make it travel.
