What's it all about . . . Restorative Practice



The Curricular Area: All areas

Why? To develop, maintain and repair positive relationships with others in school.

What? Children learn and develop the skills to make good choice now and throughout their lives.

How? By having a conversation with an adult, after a conflict or misbehavior has occurred, bringing everyone involved in the incident together and resolving the problem effectively. Typical questions asked by the adult may be:

1.What has happened.

2. What the impact has been on those involved: i.e. who has been affected and in what ways they

have been affected.

3. What needs to happen to put things right or to make things better in the future *Everyone has the chance to have their voice heard. It is carried out as a conversation in a supportive way.*
