


Internet Acceptable Use Agreement for Primary 4 - 7 Pupils

Using Safely and Effectively



- I will ask for permission before using the Internet. I can only use the Internet when a teacher or other member of staff is supervising.
- I will tell the teacher if I receive an e-mail, which asks for personal details, e.g. telephone number, home address etc.
- I will not **post** or e-mail personal details about myself, my family or any other individual.
- If I accidentally find rude, nasty or racist information, pictures, or video clips I will tell the adult who is working with me.
- I will not share my **password** with anyone.
- I am aware that all internet activity will be monitored.

Responsibility

I will take time to think before I send an email or post a message on a discussion forum.



- I will read the subject of an email carefully and think about whether it is from someone I know and can trust before I open it.
- I understand that individuals or companies own information, pictures, video and sound clips etc which they publish on the internet. I will check with the class teacher what permission is required to copy or download other individuals' or companies' pictures, video clips etc.
- I will not copy information and claim that it is my work. If I copy text from the Internet I will include its source and author in my work
- I will, under no circumstances, participate in cyber bullying. I will be polite to others online, treat them with respect and tell an adult if I come across any cyber bullying.
- If I am being cyber bullied I will tell a trusted adult.
- I will not use rude, nasty or racist language when communicating online.

Learning Successfully

- I will use the Internet for successful learning including research and study activities, email and communication forums.
- I will use recommended educational sites. I know that information accessed on the Internet may not always be accurate.
