
The South Park Way - Adapted to 'The Nursery Way'

The South Park Way is how we embed our vision into practice. You will see the South Park Way on display around the school and nursery. It is used regularly in discussion.





Within the nursey we embed the vision, values and aims using age appropriate dialogue. Alongside the Nursery Way we have the wellbeing buddies which exemplify the Shannari indicators. Each indicator has a character, which is displayed in our nursery way, to exemplify the kind of things we are looking for in our nursery way.



Our children will work towards becoming:

- Independent Iguanas
- Reflective Rattlesnakes

In South Park school we have 7 focus learner dispositions. Nursery children will use two of these dispositions in the life of the nursery to support continuity between school and our early years setting.





The vision is at the heart of the South Park and Nursery Way, alongside our 2 learner dispositions and the 4 capacities.

Our Recognition/Rewards in our Nursery Way

Our recognition board is used to celebrate the achievements of children alongside the language displayed on the Nursery Way.



In nursery we would use our recognition board to celebrate children demonstrating the Nursery Way.

Across the school and nursery we would also use house points, individual and class rewards as well as celebrating wider achievements on non uniform days.

Our Routines in our Nursery Way

- Meet and Greet
 - All staff Meet and Greet in mornings when children come into class. Each class can decide how they want to do this can be a simple 'hello' when they come in or choosing something from Meet and Greet chart e.g. high five etc
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 - Wonderful Walking
 - Wonderful Walking is the phrase used around the school to help keep everyone safe.
- Magnificent Manners
 - Magnificent Manners is a phrase used throughout the school to encourage this important skill.

Our Repair in our Nursery Way

A restorative approach is embedded in our South Park Nursery Way and at the heart of our approach to supporting our children. We continue to have individual support plans and care plans for children who require an individual approach. Our approach is tailored to meet each child, in consultation with parents/carers. Communication with parents continues to be key.
